The institution must employ a staff member who is responsible for the administration of Risk Management, Insurance or Employee Benefits on a full or part-time basis.

2 Individual Membership

Dues: \$100

Available to an educator or risk management practitioner who is not specifically involved in administrative responsibilities at an institution otherwise eligible for membership.

3 Affiliate Membership

Dues: \$850 Primary Member and Three Additional Members/\$200 Each Additional Member

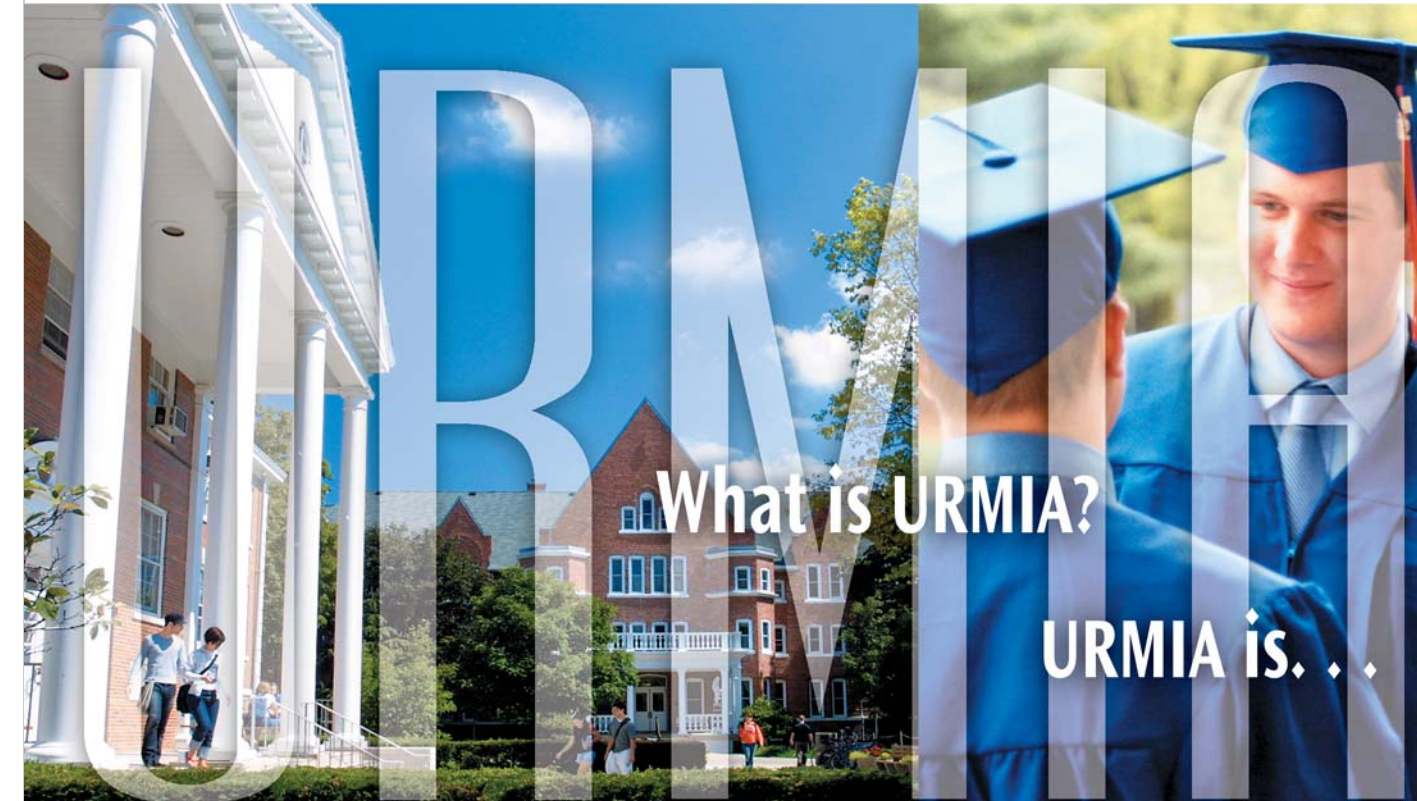

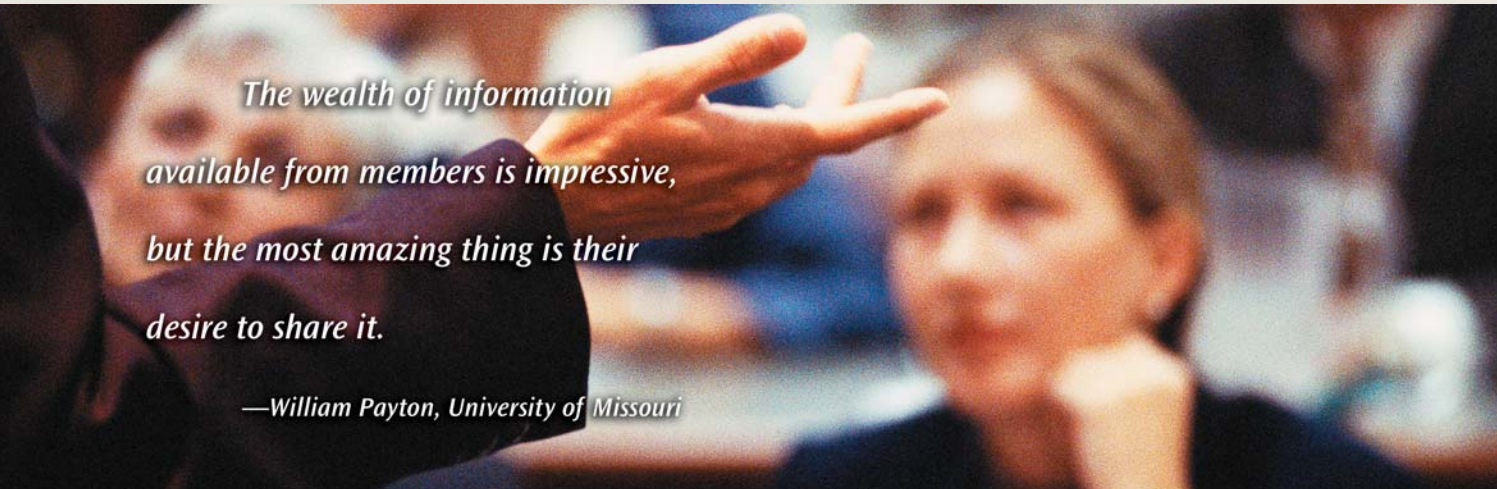

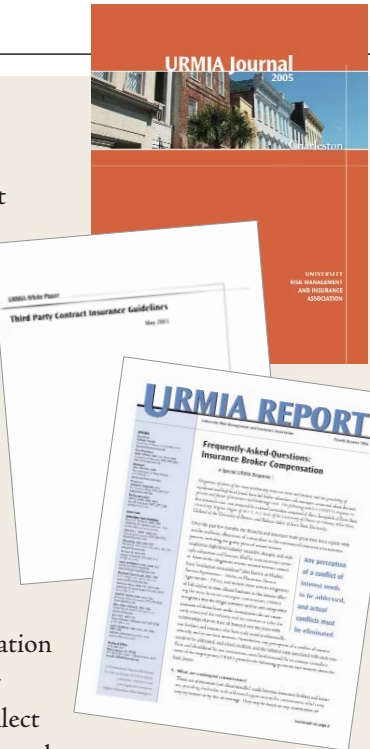
